Advanced Manufacturing Center Expansion Bluegrass Community & Technical College

The expansion covers a 13,655 GSF addition that includes high bay training spaces, 2 new classrooms, a computer classroom and collaboration spaces along with restroom and service functions to compliment the existing facility. Project cost of \$3.5 Million.

Gatton Student Center Renovation & Expansion University of Kentucky

Lexington, KY

Renovation of the existing 1938 student center building and 1924 Alumni Gym, and addition of 252,500 SF of new construction. Program includes dining services, a cinema, meeting and conference facilities, common spaces for collaboration and socialization, offices for administration and student organizations, a Barnes & Noble bookstore, and a gym. Project cost \$201,000,000. 379,000 GSF. Completed in 2018.

Harris Ballroom Fit-Up

University of Kentucky Student Center
Lexington, KY

Originally included as part of the renovation of the UK Student Center, the fit-up of the 1938 Harris Ballroom was delayed until additional funds were secured, after the completion of the main student center renovation. Omni Architects provided construction documents, project management, and construction administration services for the fit-up. Size: 17,000 SF; Project cost of \$5,500,000.

Gatton Student Center Expansion, Phase 2 University of Kentucky

Lexington, KY

The expansion of the newly constructed student center was expedited by an unprecedented increase in student enrollment and the overall success of the Phase 1 renovation and expansion. The project includes and additional 350 seats, an expansion of one cooking platform; a dishwasher/conveying system, and support equipment. Project cost \$15.1M; 34,861 GSF. To be completed in 2021.

Hunter Hall Renovation Kentucky State University

Frankfort, KY

This project requires architectural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, civil and structural consulting services for the Renovation of Hunter Hall (a former dormitory) on the main campus of the University. This renovation is a complete alteration of the existing building, with significant changes to the site and building to modify the functional use of the building. \$1,900,000

Olin Hall Renovation and Expansion Centre College

The project includes the expansion and partial renovation of Olin Hall (built in 1988), home to the College's physics, computer science, and chemistry academic programs. The project will include an approximate expansion of 8,750 SF as well as upgrades to the HVAC and other mechanical systems, improvements for ADA compliance and accessibility, and bathroom improvements.
